Getting there by car



Important note for all drivers: Our Hotel is located inside of the 'green zone' of vehicles restriction. Getting here by car an environmental badge is obligatory (valid by law since 10-01-2008). You will find more information on page 3+4.

... from direction Stuttgart A 8	
Exit „München West“	Straight into the „Verdistraße“
	Straight ahead onto „Amalienburgstraße“, „Menzinger Straße“, „Burgastraße“, „Arnulfstraße“ and „Marsstraße“
„Karlsplatz“	Turn right into „Sonnenstraße“
„Sendlinger Tor“	Turn right into „Lindwurmstraße“
	At the 7 th street turn left into „Häberlstraße“
	At the 3 ^d street turn right into „Geyerstraße“
	After 200 m the hotel is situated on the left side

... from direction Nuremberg / Airport Munich (MUC) A 9	
End of the motorway	Direction „Mittlerer Ring Ost“
„Tucherpark“	Straight into the „Ifflandstrasse“, „E.-Riedel-Strasse“, „Oettingenstrasse“, „Sternstrasse“, „Steinsdorfer Strasse“, „Erhardstrasse“ and „Auenstrasse“
„Baldeplatz“	Straight ahead onto „Auenstrasse“
	Turn 1st street right into „Geyerstrasse“
	The hotel is situated in front of you on the left side

... from direction Salzburg A 8	
Autobahnende	into „Rosenheimer Straße“
Isar	In front of the Isar turn left into „Zeppelinstraße“
	At the next traffic light turn right into „Cornelius Bridge“ across the Isar
	Right after the Isar turn left into „Erhardstraße“
	Straight ahead into „Auenstraße“
„Baldeplatz“	Straight ahead onto „Auenstraße“
	Turn 1st street right into „Geyerstraße“
	The hotel is situated in front of you on the left side

... from direction Lindau A 96	
End of the motorway	Until the of „Marstallplatz“
„Marstallplatz“	Turn left into „Maximilianstrasse“
	After approx. 300 m turn right into „Thomas-Wimmer-Ring“
„Isartorplatz“	Straight ahead onto „Zweibrückenstrasse“
	After approx. 200m turn right into „Erhardtstrasse“
	After approx. 800m straight ahead on the „Wittelsbacherstrasse“
	After approx. 10m straight ahead on the „Auenstrasse“
„Baldeplatz“	Straight ahead onto „Auenstraße“
	Turn 1st street right into „Geyerstraße“

	After approx. 200 m the hotel is situated on the left side

By public transportation	Time: about 55 min Cost: tram-ticket approx.10,- Euro
By taxi	Time: about 40 min Cost: approx. 55,- Euro

... from Hauptbahnhof Munich (main station)	
„Hauptbahnhof“	Bus line 58 direction „Silberhornstrasse“
„Baldeplatz“	get off the bus and turn left into „Auenstraße“ after the Restaurant Maharani
	After approx. 200 m the hotel is situated on the right side

By public transportation	Time: about 10 min Cost: tram-ticket approx. 2,20 Euro
By taxi	Time: about 10 min Cost: approx. 10,- Euro

... from Ostbahnhof Munich	
	S1-S8 direction „Marienplatz“
„Hauptbahnhof“	Bus Linie 58 direction „Silberhornstrasse“
„Baldeplatz“	get off the bus and turn left into „Auenstraße“ after the Restaurant Maharani
	After approx. 200 m the hotel is situated on the right side
By public transportation	Time: about 20 min Cost: tram-ticket approx. 2,20 Euro
By taxi	Time: about 20 min Cost: approx. 18,- Euro

We recommend

Ticket for one-ways:

Cost: 10,- Euro

For each zone and person needs to be stamped 2 stripes. For a short-distance (up to 4 stops after entering, but at most 2 stops with the underground and tram) you only need to stamp 1 stripe per person

Or time-tickets:

Ticket	City centre	Overall network	Valid for:
Single-day-ticket	5,- Euro	10,- Euro	One adult (from 15 years)
Partner-day-ticket	9,- Euro	18,- Euro	Up to 5 adults
Single 3-day-ticket	12,30,- Euro		
Partner 3-day-ticket	21,- Euro		

All day-tickets are valid from the postmarked date until 6 a.m of the following day. The 3-day-tickets until 6 a.m of the 4th day.

Important note for all drivers!

Environmental badge obligatory for green zones in Germany also for foreigners!



Vehicles without environmental badge may not pass through the green zone, otherwise a penalty of 40,00 € and a penalty point in Flensburg impend, even if the vehicle would be allowed to pass through the zone based on its emission value. This is also valid for all vehicles registered in foreign countries, like cars, trucks, and busses, as well as for business travellers and for tourists.

For this reason it is recommended that all drivers to inform themselves about the environmental badges, and to purchase it on time.
